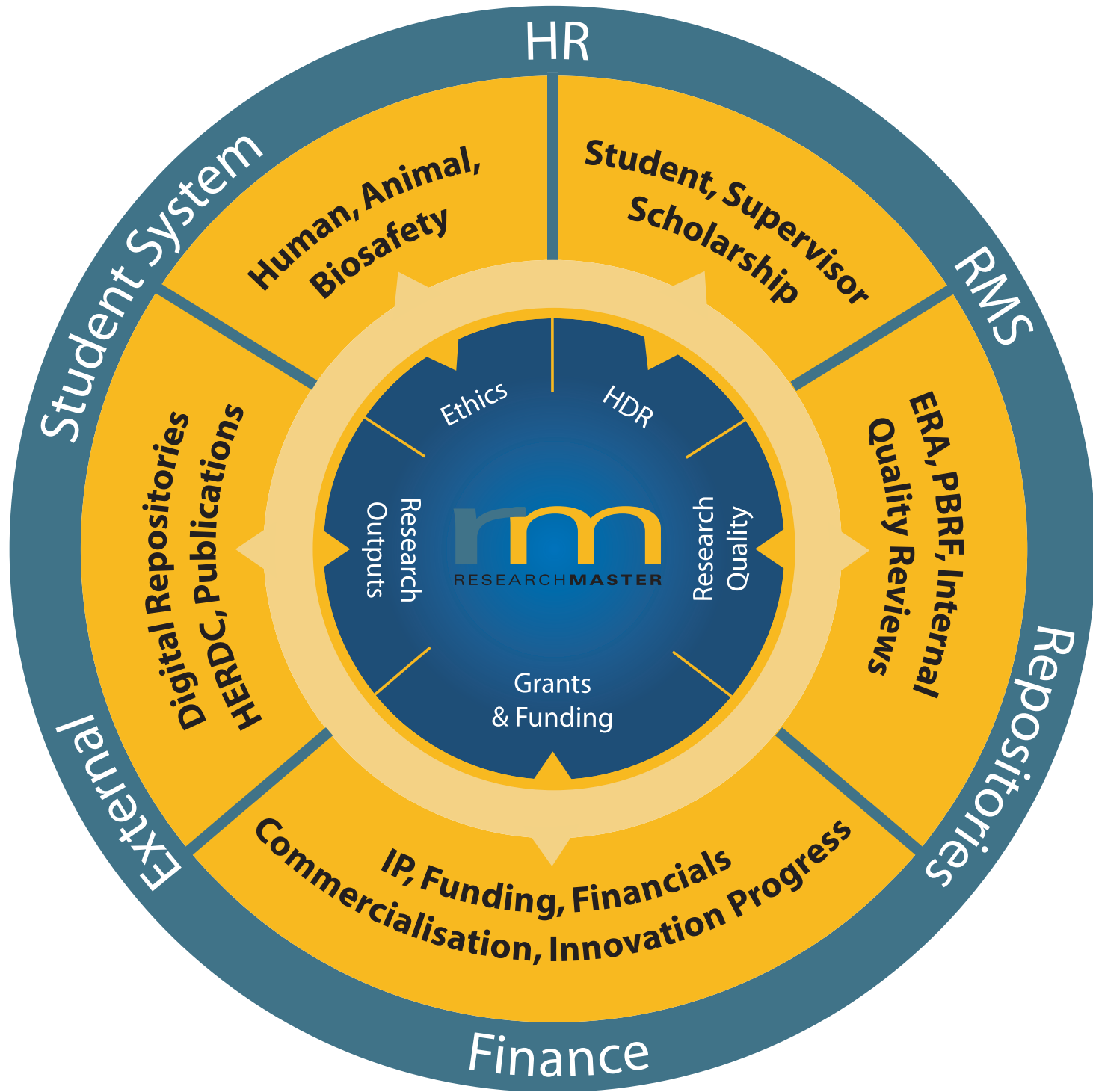

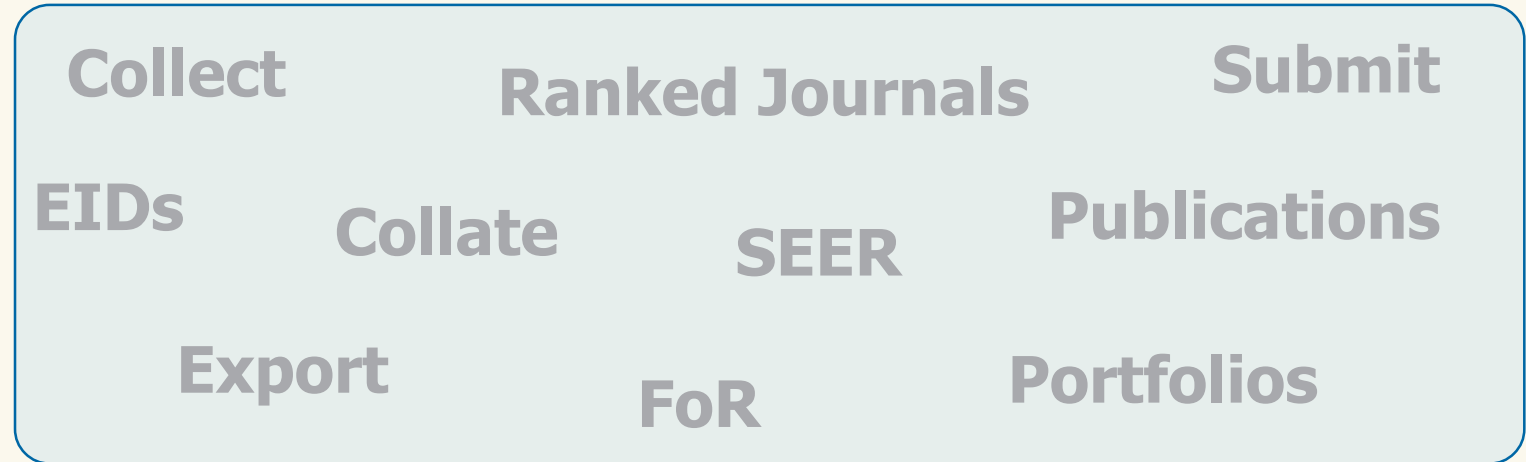

With RME ERA Assist you can collate the data, fill the gaps, validate as you go, and generate your XML file for submission.

Using the RME ERA Assist solution you can:

- Generate ERA Profiles for your eligible researchers
- Prepare your research outputs for ERA
- Import the ARC journals list and match them against your existing journals
- Extract your list of indexed journals to be sent to Scopus, and import the Scopus IDs
- Upload your research income
- Generate and review a report about your submission
- Generate the XML file required for ERA submission

PBRF

The key to Performance Based Research Funding (PBRF) is the research quality component embodied in an Evidence Portfolio. The RME PBRF solution is the comprehensive tool for the researcher to create and submit their Evidence Portfolio through internal processes, while conforming to the built-in Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) validation criteria. Evidence Portfolios can then be managed through to the final XML output for submission to the TEC.

Using the RME PBRF solution you can:

- Control the creation and assessment of Evidence Portfolios
- Create Peer Esteem and Contribution to the Research Environment records at any time, and add any of these into your Evidence Portfolio
- Select RME Research Output (RO) records as Nominated ROs and Other ROs
- Add commentaries to Nominated ROs and other aspects of an Evidence Portfolio
- Meet all TEC Evidence Portfolio validation criteria
- Submit and review Evidence Portfolios online through internal workflow, including feedback and resubmission loops
- Manage groups of Evidence Portfolios in bulk
- Generate individual Evidence Portfolio XML files for submission to the TEC
